About Department:-

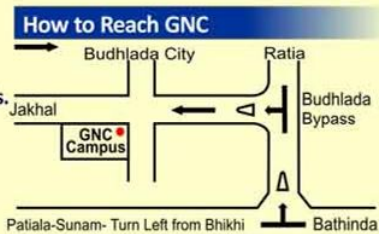
