DETAILS OF VARIOUS STUDENT WELFARE SCHOLARSHIPS/FREE SHIPS

SCHOLARSHIPS FUNDED BY STATE/CENTRAL GOVT.

SC/ST/OBC SCHOLARSHIPS

Students who belong to SC, ST or any Unscheduled Caste are recommended to be charged a fee as per government rules.

Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for SC and BC Students

Introduction: The objective of the scheme is to appreciably increase the Gross Enrolment Ratio of SC and BC students in higher education with a focus on those from the poorest households, by providing financial assistance at post-matriculation or post-secondary stage to enable them to complete their education.

Eligibility: The student must be a Punjab resident and if he/she belongs to SC category, then the annual income of parents/guardians from all sources should not exceed Rs.2.5lakh and for BC/OBC Students the income limit should not exceed 1 lakh.

Funding Agency: Department of Welfare, Government of Punjab.

Post Matric and Merit cum Means based Scholarship Scheme for Minorities

Introduction: Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Jain and Zoroastrians (Parsis) have been notified as minority communities under Section 2 (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992. A total of five (05) lakh scholarships are targeted to be distributed as 'Fresh' Scholarships, besides the Renewal scholarships. The distribution of scholarship among the States/Union Territories will be made on the basis of population of minorities in the States/Union Territories as per Census 2001 for 2017-18 and as per the population of minorities in the

States/Union Territories of Census 2011 for 2018-19 and 2019-20 (as per Appendices-A & B).

Eligibility: Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh (2.5lakh for merit cum means based).

Funding Agency: Ministry of Minority Affairs

SCHOLARSHIPS PROVIDED BY THE NON-GOVERNMENTAL INSTITUTIONS/AGENCIES

Scholarships Provided by the Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee, Sri Amritsar Sahib (An Apex Body of the Sikhs).

Amritdhari Scholarship

Students who belong to Sikh community and are baptized are eligible to apply for this scholarship

Introduction: This Scheme is available to Amritdhari Students who are studying under the various institutions run by Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee, Sri Amritsar Sahib (An apex body of the Sikhs).

Eligibility: Student must be an Amritdhari Sikh (Baptized).

Funding Agency: Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee Sri Amritsar Sahib

Scholarships Provided by the Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee (SGPC), Sri Amritsar Sahib to Students Who Participate in Sports/Cultural Activities or belonging to Financial Weaker Section

The SGPC is the Parental body of the college that provides different kinds of scholarships and free ships to the students who belong to economical weaker section who cannot afford to pay their fee due to their financial problems. Moreover, the SGPC offers scholarships to the students who participate in different types of sports and cultural activities. The criterial for the scholarship is as under:

- Students who participate in Sports and Cultural Activities: the students who participate in different kinds of sports and cultural activities are provided special free ships/scholarships from the SGPC to get their education free of cost or on concessional basis.
- Students who belong to weaker section are given scholarships/free ships who cannot afford to pay their college fee.

The students who excel and bring laurels in academic sphere are offered this scholarship by this non-governmental welfare society. Each of the 10 students are given Rs. 10,000 under this scholarship scheme.
