1. About the College

Guru Nanak College, affiliated to Punjabi University, Patiala (listed in 12(b) & 2(f) sections of UGC Act 1956) is situated on the outskirts of Budhlada city - a small town of district Mansa in Punjab. To tribute the 500th birth anniversary of "Sri Guru Nanak Dev Ji", it was started in 1971 by some eminent personalities of the region to keep in mind the noble cause of making affordable education accessible to all the people of this backward, rural and remote area. In the beginning, it was functioning under the local management but later on handed over to SGPC (Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee, Sri Amritsar Sahib), an apex and philanthropic body of the Sikhs committed to serving humanity, on 09 November 1994 due to meager financial resources and some other executive problems.

The growth of the college has been at a phenomenal pace since 2008 with a radical adjustment in a number of courses, faculty, infrastructure and other teaching learning resources. College infrastructure includes:

Administrative Block – The Administrative Block includes the Principal's Office and the Meeting Room. There is a main Library, in which we have 4 Reading halls and E resource centre. The College reception is close to the Principal's office for handling the queries of the students. The Accounts Branch and superintendent room is located near to Principal office consists of cash counter and adequate working space for the support staff.

Academic Blocks – The College has two academic Buildings consists of Blocks- Arts, Science, Commerce, Computer, Agriculture, Food Processing, Fashion technology, Music . In addition, there are 6 computer labs, 9 science labs, 11 Agriculture and Food Labs, 2 seminar halls, a conference hall and a language lab. Examination Branch – It includes office

of the Controller of Examinations, enough space for branch personnel and storage of question papers and answer sheets for college examinations.

Sports Complex - The College has a sprawling sports complex for organizing sports events and Annual Athletic Meet. College has indoor stadium for facilitating indoor games. There are enough open spaces in the College: A part of it is used for providing parking facilities. Nursery management, Lawns, Polyhouse, a Vermicompost unit and a Agrometrological observatory have also been constructed there.

At present, it has become the foremost organization in the area, having 16 PG and 14 UG courses (including 05 skill-development vocational and industry oriented courses), 134 faculty members with state-of-the-art infrastructure and technology to provide quality education.

2. About the Management (SGPC)

Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee, Sri Amritsar abbreviated as SGPC and called as mini-parliament of Sikhs, is directly elected through election by the Sikh sangat i.e. Sikh male and female voters above 18 years of age who are registered as voters under the provisions of the Sikh Gurdwaras Act, 1925.

This Act was enacted by the British Punjab Government after assent of the Punjab Governor-General on July 28, 1925, A.D. which was published first time in Punjab Gazette of August 07, 1925, A.D. This Act came into force on November 1, 1925, A.D. following its official notification No. 4288-S dated October 12, 1925, A.D.

31. Library

During this session, 1584 new books of Rs. 629935 were purchased. This year 11 journals worth Rs 21727 have been subscribed. At present 22 newspapers in English, Hindi and Punjabi languages are coming in the library. A large number of e-journals and e-books can be viewed online through these e-resources. The library is sophisticated, modern, and digitized, with additional facilities such as the N-LIST program by INFLIBNET, SOUL software, touch screen LED for easy searching of books. The library has developed its own collection database through library software. The library is fully computerized with

the barcode-based issue and return process. Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) facility has been provided in the Main Library. OPAC is widely used by students and faculty members to search books by title, author, subject name, etc. Book issue and return is fully automated in the library software using bar code technology. Free WI-FI, internet access, download, facility has been provided in the library.
